**Announcements:** Pat Jones had made a poster of some of our guild's statistics from last year which included that our membership was about 95 people, with attendance about 45 to 50 people per month. Our annual quilt show had about 500 visitors, which was an increase over previous years. We still have vacancies we need to fill on the board, and as head of committees. There is no size requirement. Quilts will be unveiled at the August meeting.

Barb Sapparito Quilters Gallery needs people to contact her to show their quilts each month.

Debbie Phillips has taken leadership of the Community Outreach Committee. She reported that our guild will be challenged to participate in two projects this year. She has several bins of fabric and supplies for these projects

- Fidget quilts- placemat sized, with objects such as zippers attached to be donated to an Alzheimer's care facility.
- Quilted postcards

Carolyn Gibbons noted that we still have the 3<sup>rd</sup> Thursday of each month reserved at the Hobby Lobby classroom for working as a group on charity projects, such as Seatbelt Buddies, which are donated to doctor's offices for cancer patients or others.
