She has held that position since 2008 and, in that time, about 20,000 quilts have been made in SC. She will tell us about the purpose of Quilts of Valor and how we can be involved. Several ladies in our guild have already been involved by quilting and binding the quilts. Our Community Outreach committee head, Diane Miller, is stepping down. She has organized ALL the fabric for comfort quilts and is ready to have the next person continue with our outreach projects for our community.

Our Hospitality committee head, Peggy Hazell, is also giving up her position, so we need to give someone else the opportunity to greet our members and guests. Both of these positions are important within our guild.

This April, 50 Quilts were dropped off at Children's Place in Aiken. Their mission at Children's Place is to protect, heal and strengthen children and families who have had trauma in their lives. Children's Place serves Aiken, Bamberg, Barnwell, Edgefield and McCormick counties. While Children's Place may look like a conventional child care or daycare facility, they are a Child and Family Development Center with the only Therapeutic Child Care program in the CSRA. The quilts will make a comfortable addition to their treatment plan.

Stand at the Crossroads, My Father's House & Crossroads Community celebrated 20 years of providing a safe haven for women and children in crisis. Our guild dropped off 15 quilts also this past April. The children residing there will now have a comfort quilt of their own from CPQ.

At our June 14 meeting we will be collecting items for the Welcome Baby Program for new mothers, sponsored by Mental Health Association of Aiken. The items include diapers, formula, wipes and clothes. Please bring some of these items to our meeting in June.


