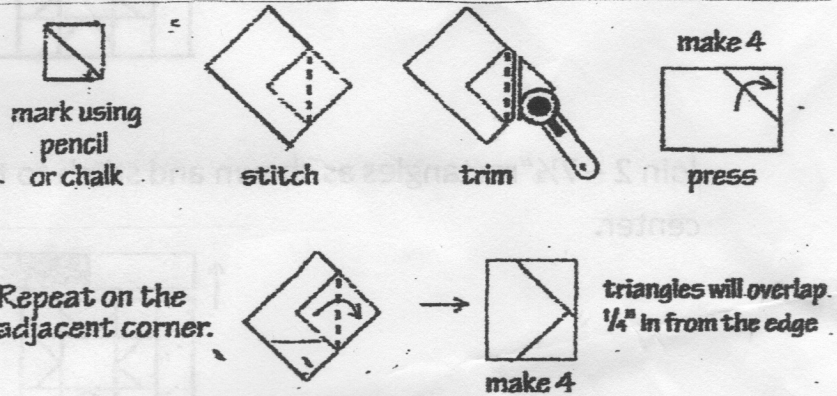


Carolina Pine Quilters Comfort Quilt Block

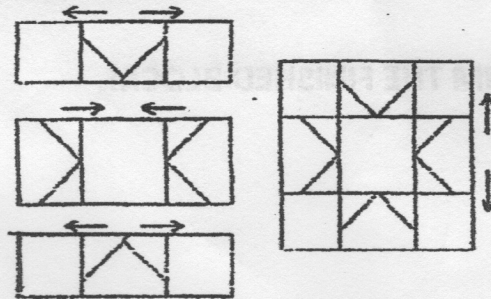
Each kit contains the following to make the star:

Background 4 – 3½" x 4½" Print 8 – 2½" x 2½"
 4 – 3½" x 3½" 1 – 4½" x 4½"

1. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of eight 2½" print squares. Place a marked square on the corner of four 3½" x 4½" background rectangles **exactly as shown**. Stitch on the line. **Please** trim corner leaving ¼" seam allowance. Press toward the corner. **Always press the direction of the arrows.**

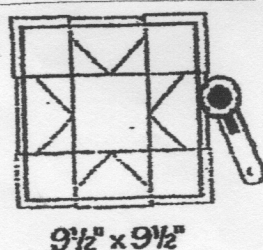


2. Arrange the step 1 units around a 4½" print square as shown. Place 3½" background squares at the corners. Stitch into rows. **Pressing in the direction of the arrows.** Stitch the rows together and press.



3. Spray the block lightly with starch or sizing. Press **both** sides making sure the seams are pressed the correct direction. This makes it much easier for the person that will do the machine quilting.

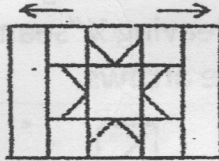
4. Trim the star block to 9½" x 9½", trimming evenly from all edges. (Trim about 1/4" from the star points.)



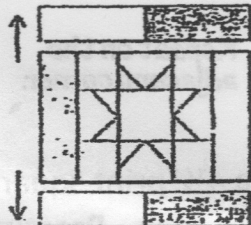
Print material for the star border: 2 - $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " and 4 - $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x ~~$7\frac{1}{2}$ "~~

$8\frac{1}{2}$ "

Stitch 2 - $9\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles to the **trimmed block** at shown. Press seams away from the center.



Join 2 - $7\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles as shown and stitch to the block. Press seams away from the center.



DO NOT TRIM THE FINISHED BLOCK!
