We had a great get together at Dunnagan's on Aug 22. We stuffed hygiene bags for the homeless. In the past month we have delivered over 40. BUT... NOW WE NEED TO FINISH. We have 26 bags left to fill. We need donations of travel size shampoo, conditioner, deodorant, bar soap and dental floss. If you would like to join together with a friend or several friends to make a bulk order from Amazon for any of these items, it is the cheapest way to purchase. For instance, you can buy an 18 pack of Degree deodorant for \$22.48 or a six pack for \$9.36. You can order 50 sets of Bergman Kelly shampoo and conditioner for \$31.99. Obviously, anything left over when we finish these bags will be used in the next round. We are providing these to several charities that help the homeless and they have said they can use anything we donate.

We also bagged 20 sets of 5 feminine hygiene pads. They will be handed out to needy women by the Homeless Coalition. If you want to help in this effort, Amazon has packages of 250 individually wrapped pads for \$52.06. There are other package sizes and prices. Just be sure they are individually wrapped.

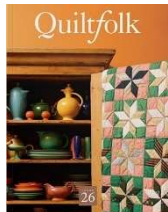
