Description of Committees

Standing Committees

Quilt Show—Traditionally held each fall at the Aiken County Historical Museum. Responsible for advertising the show, collection of quilts, display setup, ribbons and arranging for a judge.

Community Outreach—Identify and organize special projects in the community as the opportunity presents itself and/or as needed. Examples include quilts for charities, special projects for National Quilting Day, Christmas stockings for underprivileged children or home bound seniors, Linus quilts, Lydia bags. Also promote the guild by distributing CPQ brochures.

Fundraising—Plan and organize fund-raising events.

Scrapbook—Maintain the club's scrapbook with photos taken by members at club events and any news-clippings about the club or its members.

Note: As the guild's history is now maintained digitally, this committee is not currently active.

Hospitality—Responsible for having members and guests sign in at meetings; supplying and overseeing the drawing for a door prize, and assisting with special activities as requested by the president.

Membership—Maintain a membership database to be used to print out reports for the Board of Directors as needed, provide monthly updates to the Board of Directors, distribute membership directories to all members via email, oversee the construction and distribution of nametag kits and new member packets, organize and coordinate focus groups, and perform various other duties when directed by the board to enhance membership.

Operating Committees

Program—Work with the Vice President to plan and schedule programs for monthly meetings.

Website—New beginning 2020. Strengthen the guild's public interface by maintaining a current website. Forward suggestions and pertinent information to the webmaster, including programs, workshops, forms, organizational listings, photos, and other items of interest.
