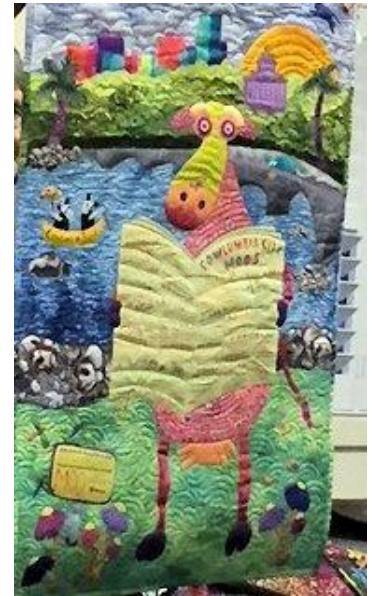

Design Inspiration from the *Fringe Sisters*

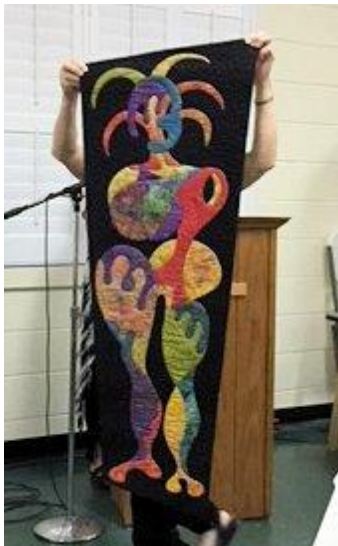
