

**“Triangle Bag”**  
(For CPQ Community Outreach)

Supplies:

- 11” x 15” fabric for body of bag (a FQ will be enough for two layers plus handle)
  - one layer is sufficient if using a heavy weight fabric
  - two layers of quilting weight fabric can be fused wrong sides together to create enough body
- 12-13” x 2” for handle, can also use webbing, cord, twill tape or sturdy ribbon
- 14” zipper

1. **(If using quilting weight fabric, fuse two pieces, wrong sides together, with Wonder Under or similar fusible.)**  
With right sides together, stitch zipper to one short edge. Press seam towards fabric and top stitch. Stitch remaining side of zipper to opposite side.  
Topstitch.
2. Flatten bag with right sides together and zipper along a fold. Stitch across bottom of bag. Finish seam allowance with zigzag.
3. Press handle fabric in half lengthwise. Press sides in to meet center crease then refold so raw edges are inside. Top stitch along both long sides. Find the center of top edge of bag. Fold handle in half and pin to the top, matching raw edges.
4. Unzip zipper to 1” below top edge. Stitch top edge of bag, right sides together, with zipper top centered and matched to ends of handle. Finish seam allowance with zig zag.  
Turn bag right side out. You’re done!
